

BEXHILL-ON-SEA TOWN COUNCIL PROJECT PLAN SCRUTINY POLICY DRAFT 20TH JULY 2022

- 1. Effective overview and scrutiny should:
 - a) provide constructive 'critical friend' challenge
 - b) amplify the voices and concerns of the public
 - c) be led by independent people who take responsibility for their role
 - d) drive improvement in public services
- 2. The Finance and General Purposes Committee shall review each project plan over £500 at the soonest possible scheduled meeting.
- 3. Each project plan must have received a majority vote RESOLUTION to proceed prior to being considered by the Finance and General Purposes Committee.
- 4. The Finance and General Purposes Committee will consider the following points when reviewing a project plan:
 - a) Have regard to 'best value' and understand that cost is not always the determining factor
 - b) Scrutiny is separated from party politics
 - c) Business case proposals and options appraisals have been made readily available to all members at least three clear days prior to the meeting
 - d) The recommendations made in the project plan should be 'SMART' i.e specific, measurable, achievable, relevant and timed
- 5. The committee recommending the project plan must pay due regard to the recommendations and/or comments of the Finance and General Purposes Committee following review.
- 6. Should the Finance and General Purposes Committee reject a proposed project plan the Committee must resubmit a plan in line with the recommendations made.
