Cllr Baldry took part in the special Bexhill-on-Sea town council proclamation ceremony to announce the new King Charles III in Devonshire Square, and both councillors attended the town council's National Moment of Reflection event at the DLWP. Cllr Gibson also attended the special requiem mass at All Saints Church, Sidley.





Ward activity

We are working with the community, businesses and residents on any issues they experience. On Thursday 22 September, we visited businesses in Sackville to find out how they're coping with difficulties like the cost-of-living crisis and increasing energy bills. The same day, we met with members of the UN group on their Witness Walk at St Barnabas Church.

We are supporting the Homeless Unity Group (HUG) based in Sea Road with a fundraising drive to raise £2,000 to ensure vulnerable residents have enough heating this winter. Both councillors are collecting egg boxes and strong plastic bags for the Bexhill food bank as they are currently short and need them urgently – please get in touch if you have any you can donate. Cllr Gibson continues to attend meetings about the possible development of the Sea Angling Club as the town council representative for this project.

As a member of the asset transfer committee, Cllr Baldry continues to be involved in discussions with RDC about the transfer of public toilets to Bexhill-on-Sea town council.
