

Pebsham Inclusive Play Area

Expected work schedule and guide



Welcome to this short guide explaining the upcoming work on the Pebsham Inclusive Play Area, supported by Bexhill-on-Sea Town Council and installed by eibe Play Ltd.

This leaflet details the length and extent of the construction, what will be included in the final result, and the benefits of the Play Area once completed.

What is being built?

Our contractors, eibe Play Ltd., are installing a brand-new Inclusive Play Area on the site indicated below:



Alongside the standard features of a play area will be more inclusive aspects, including an accessible trampoline, a wheelchair swing, and opportunities to learn the alphabet in sign language and braille. The area will measure approximately 20m x 25m, hold around 45 people, and is intended for use by ages 2-12.

When does the work begin and end?

Work on the site begins on **Monday, August 10th**, and is expected to be completed in approximately one month. We hope to hold a Grand Opening in September.
